For more than 50 years, shoemaker Ab Solomons drew a picture on the weekly wage packet he gave to his wife Celie. Chronicling their family life in the East End of London, these drawings give a historical account of a changing city. Years later, creator Danny Braverman discovered the art of his Great-Uncle Ab on more than 3000 wage packets in a shoebox, unleashing a family's secrets and truths.

A collaboration by director Nick Phillipou and Danny Braverman, Wot? No Fish!! is heart-warming piece of theatre that went on to receive the Brian Way Award for Best New Play in 2013. Like a graphic novel brought to life projected on stage, Braverman shares his family history with courage, affection and humour.

Wot? No Fish!! is also a moving historical account of London- from the 1920s, through the Second World War, and on to the 1980s - vividly recalling the family's experiences with anti-Semitism, changes to a working class neighbourhood and the challenges of caring for a disabled son. Behind the story of one family, is the story of a nation throughout the twentieth century - from blitz to boom to bust.

With thirty years' experience in theatre, Braverman is no stranger to the stage. He was a founding member with Nick Phillippou of the community theatre company bread&circuses, became Head of Education at Theatre Royal Stratford East, published his book Playing a Part: Drama and Citizenship in 2002 and became Director of the Orpheus Centre.

Nick Philippou was artistic director of the internationally acclaimed Actors Touring Company from 1993-2000. Philippou's illustrious career includes collaborations with artists as diverse as Sarah Kane, Vivienne Westwood, Laurie Anderson, Mark Ravenhill and Meow Meow, to create new pieces for performance. During his time in New York from 2001 to 2008, Philippou directed the English language premiere of Elle by Jean Genet starring Alan Cumming and Stephen Spinella and a short film Kleopatra.

Wot? No Fish!! is a small show about big things. Contained within a battered old shoebox is a portrait of family - not just of the Solomons, but everyone's - and a tribute to the extraordinary stories of ordinary people.
