Is it possible to create a show never to be forgotten by its audience members – not a single one? Performance maker and memory-spinner **Sylvia Rimat** would like to think so. With the aid of memory tasks and techniques, a live owl and the involvement of international guests appearing via Skype, Rimat systematically trains you to remember this performance – she hopes forever.

Every artist hopes their work will never be forgotten. We all wonder who will be around to remember us when we're gone. *I Guess If The Stage Exploded...* draws on presence and sight, on what happens in your brain when you create memories. It explores the perennial urge to be remembered.

Combining a surreal imagination with a deceptively dry humour, Rimat invites guests onto stage to play a part in her social experiments - participants held hostage by their own curiosity, a party celebrated in both the future and the past and the quintessential elephant in the corner. This is a one-woman show that's full of anticipation, brutal honesty and self-awareness.

For the development of the show, Rimat approached specialists in the field of memory, including a Bristol Neuroscientist, a lecturer from Experimental Psychology, a hypnotherapist and a researcher for the Centre for Death and Society. The scientific underpinnings make her social experiments on stage all the more compelling.


