In a world premiere installation by Australian photographer **Greg Barrett**, *Spongebob Squaretimes*, is an unexpected and life surging narrative. A video installation of accidental footage that exposes the audience to people-watching at its most poetic.

Shooting still images in Times Square in New York City, Barrett also recorded a short burst of video. Leaving his camera rolling, he realised he'd captured not only a surging slice of life in the Big Apple's centre, but someone in a SpongeBob SquarePants costume trying to attract the attention and generosity of passers-by for a solitary 45 minutes.

"The footage you'll see is all I shot, from start to stop. I turned the camera off when a New York cop tapped me on the shoulder and said I had to leave. But contained within the unintended length of recording is a narrative that I was completely unaware of at the time," explains Barrett.

This inadvertent depiction of loneliness and isolation in a bustling city landscape is accompanied by the soundtrack of **Simeon ten Holt's** ground-breaking composition *Canto Ostinato* played on two pianolas.

The rich and playful piece creates a joyful juxtaposition to what we visually experience. Challenging the audience with the competing emotions of sadness and alienation, *Spongebob Squaretimes* beautifully depicts the inherent human desire to connect with others.

Greg Barrett is one of the world's foremost photographers with a special interest in bodies in movement. He has worked extensively in film direction, feature film gallery still shoots, performance, fashion photography, advertising and portraiture.
