Following the sell-out successes of West Side Story (2012) and 2001: A Space Odyssey (2013), Sydney Festival relives Michel Hazanavicius' enchanting homage to silent cinema in a special screening of the modern classic. The Artist.

The film's electrifying orchestral score will be brought to life at Sydney Opera House by the Sydney Symphony Orchestra and conductor Ernst Van Tiel with the composer Ludovic Bource at the piano.

Winning five Oscars®, seven BAFTAs, six Césars and three Golden Globes. The Artist is described by its director Michel Hazanavicius as a "love letter to cinema". In the style of old Hollywood, The Artist stars Jean Dujardin as an older silent film star and Bérénice Bejo as a rising young actress. Taking place between 1927 and 1932, the duo are faced with the dawn of a new era of movies as silent cinema falls out of fashion and is replaced by "the talkies".

The Artist charmed both audiences and critics worldwide on its release in 2011. It won five Academy Awards® including Best Director, Best Actor and became the first French film to ever win Best Picture. Other accolades include three Golden Globe Awards and seven BAFTAs, making The Artist the most celebrated film in French history.

Operatic in scope, The Artist demands to be seen on the big screen, complete with the spectacular live performance of the award-winning soundtrack. The eclectic musical score, which will be performed by the Sydney Symphony Orchestra joined by composer Ludovic Bource, comprises some twenty orchestral works and reflects an array of musical styles from Hollywood's golden era.

Following the universal success of The Artist, Ludovic Bource was awarded the prestigious Chevalier de L'Ordre des Arts et des Lettres for his contribution to culture in France and most recently received an Emmy nomination for his original music in the film Clear History (2013).
